Participants will reflect on their experiences and learn from both successes and failures. The workshop will also explore the implementation of SL at different universities, including the structure, functioning, and official documentations. Additionally, the workshop will delve into how to build awareness about SL at universities and the main challenges that they currently face.

We kindly ask participants to prepare the following questions:

- tell us about your experiences in SL, case studies
- what are the most important needs? of teachers/students/community
- what can we learn from it?
- the best SL projects at your university
- the biggest failure in SL what can we learn from it?
- reflection how do you work on it?
- how implementation of SL looks at your university?
- how does it work now?
- how system looks?
- how did you work on official documents? what are the solutions, tools, tips...?
- the level of awareness about SL at your University? how to build it?
- what are your main challenges now?

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
