Practical workshop for students: **Save the World in One Semester (?)**

Aim: The aim of the workshop is to give students in interactive way basic knowledge on what SL is and how it could be applied.

Target group: students who haven't participated at SL projects. Up to 25 persons.

Total time: up to 2 hours

Content:

##	Part	Activity	Approximate time
1.	Introduction	Short introduction and mutual self presentation	5-7 min
2.	Theoretical part	The definition, meaning and advantages of SL	5-7 min
3.		Difference between SL and other similar activities (SL quadrants with the certain examples and explanation of all the examples).	10-12 min
4.	Practical part	Short discussion with students on the topic if any theoretical course could be involved in SL.	5-7 min
5.		Students are shared to 4-5 groups. Each group picks 2 cards. At first is the problem or request of the community need to be resolved or improved (pour access to drinking water, lack of public places and entertainment for youth, integration of foreign refugees etc). At the second card is the direction of studies. I prefer to chose direction that are from the first glance not considered to be "proper" for SL (IT, business administration, physics etc).	30 min
